## **National Green Tribunal (NGT)**

- Context
  - The National Green Tribunal (NGT) has set a four-month deadline for remedial actions and recovering damages from the Kulda coal mine and Tamnar thermal plant for transporting coal through villages in violation of environmental clearance (EC) conditions.

## Key Highlights:

 Kulda coal mine is being run by Mahanadi Coalfields Limited (MCL) in Odisha and the Tamnar thermal plant operated by Jindal Power Limited (JPL) in Chhattisgarh.

#### Kulda-Tamnar Coal Link

- It is developed by (C-DAC), Kolkata in collaboration with ICAR-CIFRI, Baraackpore under the 'National programme on Electronics and ICT applications in Agriculture and Environment (AgriEnlcs).
- It is used for qualitative and quantitative analysis of Endocrine Disrupting Chemicals (EDC) content in water bodies.

- The Bio sensing based EDC detection system was also transferred for further commercialization.
- The Centre for Development of Advanced Computing (C-DAC), Kolkata in collaboration with TeXMIN, ISM, Dhanbad under the 'National programme on Electronics and ICT applications in Agriculture and Environment (AgriEnlcs)' has developed an outdoor air quality monitoring station.
